XCO “Sigulda Cup” UCI C2 2018

16.09.2018., Latvia, Sigulda



XCO "Sigulda Cup" UCI C2 2018 race will take place in one of the most beautiful and picturesque place of Latvia – Sigulda. A unique opportunity to race in a green, clean and lovely place with forests, hillocks and near the river Gauja. Sigulda is the most popular tourist destination in Latvia, include the ruins of the Sigulda Castle, the Cable Car, the Aerodium, the Sigulda Bobsleigh and Luge Track, the Gutmanis Cave, the Turaida Museum Reserve and other interesting locations right nearby!

Race course consists of nature trails with wood and rock obstacles, gravel roads, nature trails with woodchip surface, pavement. Some of the most technical obstacles have „chicken lines” for everyone to be able to pass the element. Race course is marked and is available for trainings before race.

Race "Sigulda cup 2018 XCO UCI C2" will be organised according to UCI Regulations.

Women Elite – must have a valid WE or WU23 cycling licence (1999 year of birth and older)

MEN Juniors – must have a valid MJ (2000 and 2001 year of birth)

WOMEN Juniors – must have a valid WJ cycling licence (2000 and 2001 year of birth)

Men OPEN (2004 year of birth and older)

Women OPEN (2004 year of birth and older)

Elite 1st-30points, 2nd- 20, 3rd- 15, 4th- 12, 5th- 10, 6th-8, 7th-6, 8th-4, 9th-2, 10th-1

Juniors 1st-20points, 2nd -18, 3rd- 16, 4th- 14, 5th- 12, 6th-10, 7th-8, 8th-6, 9th-4, 10th-2

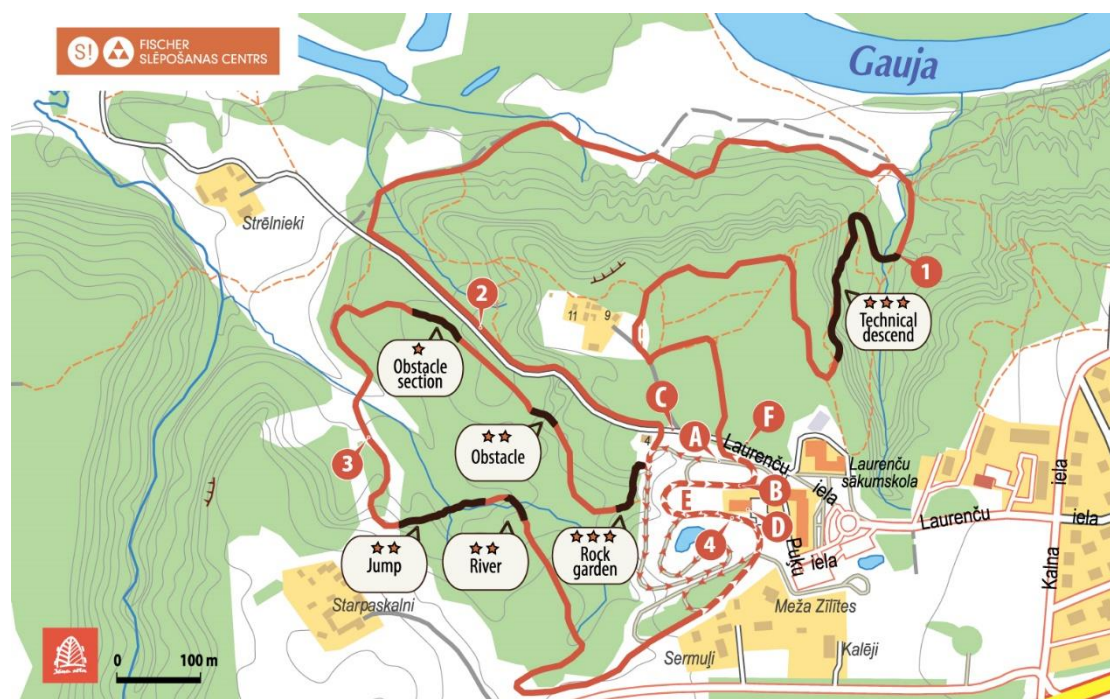

Race course

Race course is located in Gauja river valley. Course consists of nature trails with wood and rock obstacles, gravel roads, nature trails with woodchip surface, pavement. 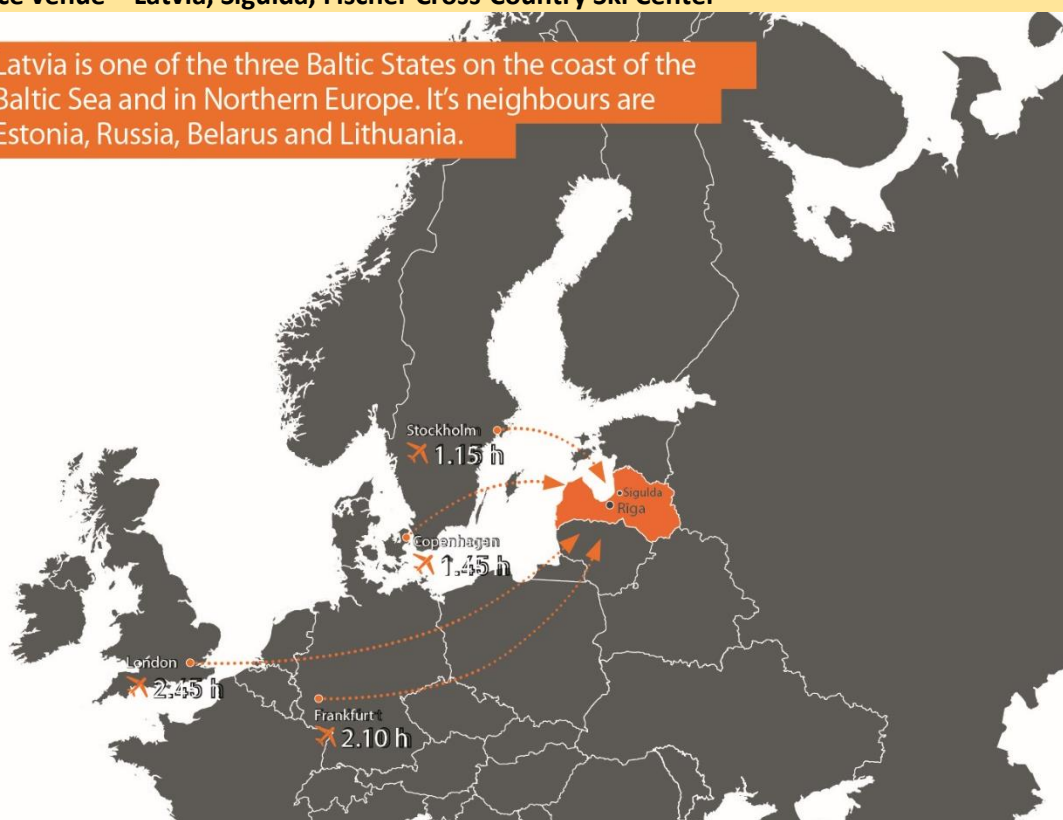

Race venue – Latvia, Sigulda, Fischer Cross-Country Ski Center

Fischer Cross-country Ski Center, opened in November 2013, is first of its kind refrigerated cross country skiing track in Eastern Europe. In winter visitors are provided with high quality cross country skiing track. In the warm part of the year everyone is welcome to use the facilities of Fischer Cross-country Ski Center for different activities - roller skating, roller skiing, cycling, nordic walking and running. In the centre there is also roller skiing, roller skating and nordic walking equipment rental. Services at Fischer Cross-Country Ski Center: showers, sauna, wardrobe, beverage and snack vending machine.

Specific rules

- A safety helmet is required! If the participant competes without a helmet or with an unfastened helmet, they will get disqualified;
- The results of the participants get recorded electronically. By repeatedly crossing the finish line, the participant places last in crossing time and the ranking;
- The punishment for crossing the finish line from the opposite direction is disqualification;
- If the participant arbitrarily shortens the distance, they will get disqualified;
- It is recommended that the participants take the following with them in the race: a pump, a spare camera, a bottled beverage and a mobile phone;
- Any cyclist who believes that they have been restricted by some action in the time leading up to the crossing of the finish line, can submit a written protest by paying EUR 20 to the chief judge of the competition within 30 minutes of crossing the finish line. If the protest gets approved, the fee (EUR 20) is repaid to the person who submitted the protest;
- The judges have the right to collaborate with the organizers in deciding on matters which have not been mentioned in the competition regulations;
- By applying to the competition, each participant confirms with their signature that they assume full responsibility of their physical fitness for the completion of the race and that they will follow the road traffic provisions and the competition regulations;
- Parents or caregivers take responsibility for participants under the age of 18, and confirm their responsibility with a signature by applying to the competition in the secretariat;
- The organizers and all the other people who are involved in the organization of the competition do not take responsibility for any direct, indirect, unexpected or expected physical and material losses incurred by the participants of the competition, whether they take place before or after, or during the competition;
- The organizers will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions. The organizers decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.
- By confirming their participation in the competition, the participants forgo the rights to raise objections to the organizer or other people involved in the organization of the competition if they encounter possible accidents or material losses, and they do not file a damage claim to bring the case before Court;
- The organizers are not liable to the participants if they are not familiar with or do not follow these regulations;
- A microchip system is used to record the results. During the competition, the participant is responsible for keeping the microchip safe and not losing it. If the microchip gets lost, the participant has to pay a fee of EUR 50.

Privacy Policy

The participant and the competitor is informed that during the course of the event, video and photographic material may also be taken by "Siguldas Sporta serviss" Ltd., by the organizer of the event, by the event judges, and by other authorised persons, and that the competition results may be published. By applying to the event as a participant or by attending it in person, the visitor agrees that photographic or video material may be taken of them, that their image may be used in films, photographs or audiovisual recordings, that
